Instructions for Abstract Submission

Abstract Submission is performed only electronically by using the on-line submission system.

The abstract must be written in English.

When you start, sign in as a New Account and give your valid email address. The system will automatically generate an email with an Access Key for you to use in case you need to return to edit your paper. If you wish, you can change the Access Key by clicking Change Password.

Topic areas (of which you must choose one)

Complications

Experimental

Heart

Infection and immunology

Kidney

Liver + small intestine

Long-term Outcome

Organ donation + organ preservation

Pancreas + islets

Abstracts shall be submitted as attachment files. Allowed formats are PDF, DOC, TXT, and RTF. The maximum size of the attachment is 10 MB.

The maximum size of the abstract is 250 words. The 250 words limit does not include the title of the abstract; the limit is for the actual text of the abstract.

Do not include any author or organization data in the title or the text of the abstract, as the reviewing of the abstracts will be 'blind'.

Use Arial font, minimum size 8 in black.

Prepare your paper on your computer, save it in one of the allowed formats and upload it to the system. Your paper (the file you submit) can include pictures, tables and graphs. When choosing

pictures and graphs, please take into consideration that the Extended Program will be printed in black and white.

After browsing the paper from your files, you submit the papers by clicking CONTINUE.

When you are happy with the submitted paper, click LOG OUT to exit.

You can log out whenever you want and return to the system with your Access Key and continue with the upload. You can also replace – until the submission deadline - the paper with a new version. If you return to the system, you will find your submitted papers under Show Papers.

The dead-line for abstract submission is **March 31, 2010**.

After this date you can no longer replace your paper.

Accepted contributions will be presented either as posters, or according to the decision of the Scientific Committee, as oral presentations.

Authors will be notified of acceptance of their contributions and the type of presentation (oral or poster) by April 18, 2010.

All the abstracts will be published in an Extended Program for the congress (in black and white).
